BYE showed speed, contested pace to turn, battled DOUBLE RIDE into the stretch, shook free of the runner-up in the late stages and drew clear in deep stretch. DOUBLE RIDE showed speed, contested pace from the inside, battled BYE into upper stretch, was turned away nearing the final sixteenth and held well for the place. AZTEC SUN chased three to four wide to quarter, closed willingly in the lane, missed for second and was up in time for third. LITE RANCHIN KID crowded outer rival at the start, chased inside into the turn, angled three wide upper, flattened out in the late stages, lost third. RUGGS broke out and crowded outer rival at the start, settled inside to the turn, saved ground to stretch, no late rally. WICKED TROUBLE crowded, took up start, trailed to turn, coaxed two wide into the lane, was caught in traffic into the final sixteenth and lacked the needed late response. BYE BYE LIAM settled to the turn, chased three wide to quarter, swung widest to upper stretch and could not muster the needed late response. THE STEWARDS CONDUCTED AN INQUIRY INTO THE START, AND RULED NO CHANGE WOULD BE MADE. IN ADDITION, THE JOCKEY OF WICKED TROUBLE LODGED AN OBJECTION AGAINST THE JOCKEYS OF LITE RANCHIN KID AND BYE BYE LIAM, CLAIMING INTERFERENCE AT THE START. THE STEWARDS DISALLOWED THAT OBJECTION.
