STONEHENGE bobbed at the start and broke a step slowly, showed good speed and contested the early pace from inside of a pair of rivals, disputed the pace to the quarter marker then shook free to upper stretch, drew off through the lane and was ridden out to the wire to win as much the best. MAN OF MISCHIEF broke in at the start then rushed up and pressed the early pace three wide, chased STONEHENGE to the quarter marker then ran in pursuit of the winner into the lane, was no match late for STONEHENGE and bested the rest to earn the place honors. L SQUARED showed good early speed, pressed the pace between foes and two wide to the turn, turned away into upper stretch, chased STONEHENGE into the lane, was outkicked for second and held safely in the end for third. APURO contested the early pace from the inside then took back, stalked the contested pace while saving ground into the turn, chased STONEHENGE into the stretch, weakened in the final stages and was outfinished for the minor awards. SENOR ROJO broke a bit slowly then chased the early leaders along the backstretch, ran in pursuit two wide to the quarter pole and lacked the needed late response. PEVS DISTANT DRUM ducked in at the start then was erratic in the early stages and spotted the field to begin, trailed to the quarter marker, made up ground into the stretch but could not sustain that run and did not factor late.
