IVORY MOON raced close up to the early pace, chased three wide to the quarter marker then took command into upper stretch, met the bid of WHIMSICAL HEIR at the furlong marker, dug in while under pressure into the final sixteenth, was unyielding to deep stretch and denied the runner-up in the final yards for a determined win. WHIMSICAL HEIR got shuffled back at the start, recovered to be well placed to the turn, mounted a four wide bid to upper stretch, confronted IVORY MOON nearing the furlong pole and gamely battled that rival to the final sixteenth, was denied for the win in deep stretch and was well clear of the rest for second. TURN ON ARCH broke a step slowly, recovered and chased the pace two wide and between rivals into the turn, angled to the rail into upper stretch and ran in pursuit to the furlong pole, flattened out in the drive but held clearly in the end for third. BOSTON PRINCESS prominent away from the gate, vied for the early lead from between rivals then set the pace to the turn, showed the way to the quarter marker while off of the rail, was overtaken into upper stretch and weakened in the lane. LOOKATHERGLIDE broke in at the start and was allowed to settle early, coaxed four wide to upper

stretch, needed more in the lane and passed tiring rivals late. O'NEILL'S LEGACY raced close up to the early pace, chased three to four wide to the quarter marker, ran in pursuit to upper stretch and lacked the needed late response. ALLABOUTTHEIMAGE got squeezed at the start and was off slowly, settled outside of rivals to the turn, swung five wide to upper stretch, could not threaten the leaders in the drive but improved position in the late stages. INDIAN EXCELLENCE broke a bit slowly but recovered to be well placed early on, saved ground to the turn, lost position at the quarter marker, tipped out two wide to upper stretch and gave way in the drive. OUR SOARING ANGEL lunged then was shuffled back at the start and spotted the field to begin, trailed to the turn and did not factor in the stretch drive. SHOPPING ACCIDENT hustled away from the start, contested the early pace from the inside, dropped back along the turn and came up empty in the stretch.
