SAMBAS MARK settled off of the solid pace early, was unhurried to the turn then asked for run five wide to upper stretch, responded in the lane and made a bold rally to the final sixteenth, took command in deep stretch and won going away. PROBATE allowed to settle early on, coaxed two wide to upper stretch, angled to the rail nearing the furlong marker, closed willingly into the final sixteenth and got up for the place honors. MISTER WU showed early speed and pressed the pace outside of LARIAT, took command nearing the quarter marker then led to upper stretch, maintained a clear lead into the final furlong, got collared by the winner in the final sixteenth and was outfinished for second, while holding safely for third. DELBERT TOO settled off of the early pace, saved ground into the turn then advanced two wide into upper stretch, was caught in traffic nearing the final sixteenth, angled out in deep stretch but could not muster the needed late response. BRANDYN settled in mid-pack early on, chased three wide to the quarter pole then was caught in traffic to upper stretch, bid between rivals nearing the furlong marker, could not sustain that run to the final sixteenth and flattened out late. DIABOLICAL STORM got bumped hard at the start and trailed in the early stages, was given his cue at the quarter pole, swung widest to upper stretch and offered a mild late rally. ONE MARK well placed in the early stages, saved ground into the turn, ran in pursuit to the quarter pole then tipped three wide to upper stretch, chased into the final furlong but could not find the needed late response. RISKY REVENGE allowed to settle in the early running, coaxed three to four wide to upper stretch, lacked the needed response in the drive and failed to threaten late. SIDEWINDER SLICK chased the early leading pair, ran in pursuit three wide to the quarter pole then spun four wide to upper stretch, could not keep pace into the final furlong and weakened. LARIAT broke alertly and was sent for the early lead, set a contested pace into the turn, overtaken to upper stretch, stopped in the final furlong, was eased through the lane and walked off.
