DORA'S STORM was away alertly to stalk the pace from three wide and engaged the leader near the three furlong marker and took the lead midway through the turn, drew clear to prove best. SEAHAWK CODY tracked the leaders to midway through the turn then moved up to make a four wide late run on the leader and was second best. PRAY FOR ME RAY raced within striking distance from off the rail down the backstretch then saved ground on the turn and made a rail bid in the stretch but was outfinished. SILVER DADDY trailed the field to the top of the stretch then made a mid track rally to improve his position. JETFIRE roused to the front to press the pace from two wide to the three furlong marker before weakening. COG rushed to a pressured lead to past the three furlong marker before being collared midway through the turn but fought on to the top of the stretch and gave way. BURNZ DA BOSS raced off the pace through the turn, shifted out to three wide into the stretch then out further in early stretch but lacked a late response. OHHH DADDY saved ground throughout but was always back.
