TRUE LOVIN close up early on, stalked the pace three deep into the turn, vied for the lead into upper stretch, took command into the final furlong and kicked clear late. BRANDON'S GIRL was crowded at the start and last away from the gate, rushed up approaching the turn, chased four wide heading to the quarter pole, crowded a bit by TRUE LOVIN into upper stretch, could not match strides with the winner into the lane and stayed on to be second best. GIRLS DON'T CRY broke in at the start, took early command then set the pace to the turn, led while off of the rail nearing the top of the lane, dug in to mid-stretch, yielded to the top pair in the final sixteenth and just held at the wire for third. POWER NAP settled outside of rivals early on, maintained a wide trip to the quarter pole, asked five wide to upper stretch, needed more into the final sixteenth and just missed at the wire for third. WILD STEEL settled in the early running, advanced into the turn then tracked the pace two wide and between rivals nearing the quarter pole, shifted three wide for the drive and flattened out in the late stages. DISCREET PLEASURE bobbed at the start, rushed up in the early going and tracked the pace from the inside heading into the turn, ran in pursuit to mid-stretch then weakened in the final sixteenth. MISS KENZIE was close up to the early pace, pressed between rivals into the turn, lost position nearing the quarter pole and gave way in the drive. HAZHONI rated off of the early pace, ran in pursuit three to four wide and between rivals along the turn, lacked the needed response to upper stretch and did not threaten late.
