HOODLESS missed the break, advanced through the middle stages to be close up to the leaders approaching the quarter pole, continued the move to bid four-wide at the head of the stretch, then produced a steady finish to be up in plenty of time. ROPERS N WRANGLERS tracked the pace on the inside within striking distance, took the lead in upper stretch but could not hold off the winner. HER BLIND SIDE was outpaced a bit coming off the first turn, maintained an inside position always in range of the leaders, dropped to last late on the backstretch but came back on late to gain the minor award. GLOBAL ALLURE chased the pacesetter three wide to the far turn, bid three-wide off the last turn but was outfinished in the stretch run. SOUTHRN SWEETHEART came away from the gate awkwardly, dropped far behind early, saved ground, regained contact with the field down the backstretch and improved. LIBBIES BABY raced four to five wide throughout near the rear of the field and was mildly gaining ground in the stretch. MINEDANDREFINED was sent aggressively to a clear early lead, dug in under threat approaching the quarter pole, then finally gave way with a sixteenth to run.
