BOB'S DECISION was unhurried, rallied six-wide into the stretch and finished fast to be up in the final strides. MOON SHINE TIME was forwardly placed racing two-wide, moved up to take the lead from GONZAGA BAY inside the eighth pole and then just failed to last. BAMBY BOOM saved ground while e=being allowed to settle and rallied late. HERECOMEGEORGIEBOY was reserved early racing three-wide, came four-wide into the stretch and lacked a rally. DOUBLECHECK raced in the back of the field early, moved forward nearing the quarter pole racing four-wide, came five-wide into the stretch to offer a bid and then flattened out late. GONZAGA BAY saved ground setting the early pace, drifted out during the drive and weakened. DIXON TUFF was prominently placed early racing four-wide and tired. WARRENS WORLD chased GONZAGA BAY early racing two-wide and gave way.
