KATIE KING prompted the pace inside, vied for the lead passing the half, inched away around the far turn, was cued passing the quarter, kicked away while being ridden out down the lane, and was wrapped up late. MIGHTY HEARTLESS tracked between foes in the two path, was driven along while off the rail around the far turn, could not keep up with the winner down the stretch, but was clearly second best. LADY LYL A showed the way in the two path, lost the lead while coming under a ride passing the three eights pole, gave way from the three path down the lane, but held show. WINNING SHOT chased inside, angled out under a drive passing the quarter, then floated out to the six path in upper stretch, and made no closing bid. I'M HUNGOVER bumped with an outer foe at the start, sta;ked in the three path, was coaxed along around the far turn, but weakened from the four path in the stretch. NEW CENTSATION was wellback in the two path and did not factor. LILY DASH A bumped with an inner foe at the start, rated in the four path but retreated around the far turn. AUNT JOSSY trailed inside up the backstretch and never threatened.

CHACARERA tracked in the two path, was cued from the four path midway around the far turn, ranged up to bid turning into the lane, held a narrow lead while dueling with an inner foe passing the furlong grounds, and held on. BRAVO KITTEN raced off the pace in the two path, moved up along the rail to bid passing the quarter, dug in while dueling with an outer foe to the wire, but was edged out. UNICYCLE set the pace in the two path, was pushed along around the far turn, lost the lead while between foes at the top of the lane, and faded but held show. MISHKA chased in the four path up the backstretch, dropped back under a drive entering the far turn, but was one paced to pass tired foes from the three path in the stretch. HUMOR SENSE pressed in the three path, was driven around the far turn, steadied between foes passing the quarter, and yielded from the five path down the stretch. WHITE CLAW WOMAN (IRE) stalked in the three path, was driven from the two path into the far turn, but gave way down the lane. SPECIAL AFFAIR trailed outside of foes early, moved up heading up the backstretch, was ridden in the four path around the far turn, but made no closing bid. OOPS HAHA raced in midpack along the inside but did not threaten. CHEERFUL TROUT was wellback in the four path and never menaced.

MOR SPRING SPIRIT dueled for the lead in the three path, took command while in the two path passing the three-eighths pole, merged to the rail entering the lane, and drew clear. SECRET EMPIRE chased outside of rivals in the five path, was ridden in the four path around the turn, and ran on clearly be second best. IN SKY WE TRUST tracked in the two path, was driven in the three path around the turn, angled out to the six path at the top of the lane, and kept on to get up for show. PAYNTED WARRIOR bumped with an inner foe at the start, vied for the lead inside, lost ground while coming under a ride passing the quarter, and flattened in the two path down the stretch. MORNING CUP rated between foes in the three path, angled to the rail under coaxing passing the quarter, but lacked a final bid. DUNDIE raced up close in the two path, was pushed along while off the rail around the turn, tipped out to the three path in upper stretch, but faded. AXEL STEEL prompted the pace in the four path but yielded down the lane. MY MAN WOODY bumped with an outer foe at the start, trailed in the three path and did not threaten. CROSS HASTE was wellback along the inside and never menaced.
