SULION raced in the two path around the first turn, led the way on the inside up the backstretch, continued around the far turn still in the two path and kicked clear in the lane. RED SKY MORNING raced in the two path early, settled off the pace on the inside for the run up the backstretch, came around the second bend in the four path, began a bid entering the stretch and gained ground late. SPEAKER'S LOBBY raced in the three path around the first bend, settled in the middle of the pack for the run up the backstretch, began a bid from the four path coming around the far turn and improved position in the stretch. JUAN CAMANEY raced in the three path around the first turn, tracked the leader on the outside up the backstretch, navigated the far turn still in the three path, dueled in the stretch and chased on late. NO MERLOT raced in the two path early, chased the leader on the inside up the backstretch, saved ground around the second bend and was outkicked in the final furlong. DEVILMENT raced in the middle of the pack on the inside through the opening half mile, continued to save ground around the far bend and made no bid. JOBU raced in the two path around the first turn, settled in the middle of the pack

between horses for the run up the backstretch, came around the far turn still in the two path and was empty in the stretch. HAPPY MOMENTS raced into traffic from the four path headed into the first turn, continued up the backstretch in the middle of the pack on the outside, saved ground around the far turn and tired in the lane. UNANSWERED PRAYERS raced in the five path early, settled off the pace on the outside for the run up the backstretch, saved ground around the second turn and made no bid.
