NOBLE ANNIE saved ground off of the pace, progressed into upper stretch, bid two wide and between rivals at the furlong grounds, battled while headed by an outer foe into the final furlong and gamely forged an advantage in the shadow of the wire. MISTRIAL WIND tracked along the inside, tipped out in upper stretch before bidding three wide and between rivals at the furlong grounds, led into the final sixteenth, sparred with an inner rival late and could not last.

SHE'S THE RAGE broke a step slow, checked slightly between horses at the seven furlong pole, saved ground at the rear, rallied in upper stretch, tipped to the four path into the final furlong, progressed belatedly to offer a bid at the wire but came up short. CHABELITA stalked two wide, ranged up to bid nearing the lane, but drifted out in midstretch and yielded to inner foes. MISSUS SEKI broke a step slow, laid well back in the four path advanced outside of rivals around the far turn, fanned to the six path into upper stretch and leveled off. RIPPLE bumped with an inner foe at the start, sped clear early on, met an outer challenge nearing the lane, got headed by an outer trio at the furlong grounds and weakened. CAPARBIA leaned out and bumped a foe at the start, lacked speed in the three to two path, trailed turning for home and failed to factor. LA JEFACITA tracked from midpack two wide, chased two to three wide and among foes around the far turn then gave way. STORM SEARCH stalked along the inside, gave way in the two path around the far turn and weakened between rivals nearing the lane. BELLA COCO pursued from the three path then faded between horses into the far turn and was done early.
