MIESHA broke outward bumping DDOLCE MARIE into GOOSEBUMPS, stalked the pace three wide, rallied six wide through upper stretch to make the lead near the furlong marker and won under confident handling. GOOSEBUMPS was bumped sat the start, railed into the stretch then closed rapidly along the rail in a determined effort. COMPUTE THIS broke through the gate prior to the start, upon being reloaded, settled close up inside rivals, shifted three wide entering the stretch, exchanged bumps with COUNTRY PROMISES and finished with good courage. COUNTRY PROMISES close up two wide, exchanged bumps with CUMPUTE THIS in mid stretch then improved position ;ate. PERFECT ANGEL rushed to the lead, set a pressured pace inside the two wide until mid stretch then weakened. DYNAMIC VISION pressed the early pace two wide and was through after a half. DOLCE MARIE was bumped at the start then no factor. THE STEWARDS POSTED THE INQUIRY SIGN BUT TOOK NO ACTION.
