VODKATINI shifted out four then five wide down the backstretch, closed willingly under left handed urging through deep stretch and got up in the final strides. BLAZING ZENNA trailed into the stretch circled her field through the final furlong and got up for second. TIZZY JOJO stalked the early pace two wide, saved ground through the turn, slipped through to make the lead in upper stretch, edged clear and was caught in the final stages. FIONA chased the pace three wide and went evenly. LADY GIULIANA failed to menace. VITAEMI sprinted to a clear lead soon after the start, set the pace into the stretch then was used up.
