SHARP AZ CAN BE sprinted to the lead soon after the start, set all the pace, widened into the stretch, drifted from the two path to the five path under left handed urging late and lasted. STARCOURT stalked the pace near the inside, drifted out to the six path in upper stretch and was steadily cutting into the winners advantage late. QUICK RECOVERY never far back, finished with good courage in the seven path. LADY GIULIANA trailed into the stretch and found her best stride late outside. BLAZING ZENNA failed to menace. FULL TIME STRUTIN chased the winner three then two wide into the stretch then faded.
