WE'LL DO IT LIVE angled in shortly after the start causing a chain reaction of bumping to her inside, sprinted clear, set all the pace unchallenged and won under left handed urging. CHESS NOT CHECKERS never far back, was steadily gaining ground late in the middle of the racetrack. GRACIE DANCE slow early, closed with a rush in deep stretch also in the middle of the racetrack. TIMELY SECRET was bumped between horses at the start then failed to menace. BEACHES AND PEARLS was forced inward by the winner bumping a rival to her inside, chased the pace three wide into the stretch and weakened lane. ABSOLUTE MIRACLE was bumped from her outside at the start, chased the winner two, angled in midway onto the bend, kept on to the furlong marker then gave way. MAGIC PALACE had brief speed. GEORGIA ON E'SMIND vied for the lead along the rail into the turn, was in tight causing her rider to checked past the five sixteenths pole then lost momentum.
