GHOST BIKE slow early, closed rapidly in the middle of the racetrack under left handed urging through the stretch and was along in time. SO DIALED IN pressed the pace two wide past the five eighths pole, made the lead, set the balance of the pace, shook clear in upper stretch then couldn't handle the winner. Z BOSS unhurried early, finished determinedly along the inside. HARBOUR BRIDGE moved up three then four wide into the stretch then leveled off. SKIBIDI RIZZ set the pace past the five eighths pole, chased the leader until deep stretch and faded late. LOONY threw his head at the start missing the break then trailed throughout. STAR WEAVER vied for the lead three wide into the stretch, stopped abruptly, pulled up near the sixteenth pole and was walked off.
