JOHN'S ROCK never far back, rallied through deep stretch five wide under left handed urging and was along in time. P H FACTOR set a pressured pace two then three wide until the final yards then couldn't hold off the winner. AUGER stalked the pace along the inside into the stretch, loomed boldly between rivals two wide at the furlong marker then was outfinished. DON'T STOP pressed the pace along the inside past the furlong marker and weakened late. AGNELLO'S DREAM was no factor. MACHISMO stalked the pace three wide down the backstretch, loomed boldly nearing the quarter pole then came up empty.
