BEAUTIFUL MANDATE never far back, rallied five wide through the stretch under left handed urging to made the lead in deep stretch and drew clear under strong handling. CANDYMONIUM trailed into the stretch, rallied late in the middle of the racetrack and got up for second. WICCA WISDOM pressed the pace two wide into the far turn, made the lead nearing the quarter pole, set the pace until deep stretch then was outfinished. GEORGIA ON E'SMIND bumped at the start, stalked the pace three wide into the far turn, drew on near even terms for the lead approaching the top of the stretch then was outfinished. ELIKA bumped at the start, settled, surged past rivals four wide to make the lead near the seven sixteenth pole, was headed before the quarter pole, kept on into the stretch then was used up. HERE KITTY KITTY set the pace along the inside past the seven sixteenths pole, steadied along the rail early on the far turn then gave way in the lane.
