SUSIE'S KID was allowed to settle early, rallied in the stretch, split horses and edged clear late under strong handling. MAY MAYHEM was unhurried early, swung six wide in the stretch, rallied and was up for place. LITTLE TOY GUNS was allowed to settle early swung five wide in the stretch and finished willingly . PROSECUTOR dueled on the lead and weakened late. FACT NOT FICTION vied for the lead three wide and faltered late. MUTINY pressed the pace three wide and faltered late. INTO GOLD contended early and tired in the stretch.
