KNICKS GLORY with the second flight, circled rivals four wide through the turn, made the lead at the top of the stretch and drew off late under mild left handed urging. VODKA N GINGERALE unhurried early, rallied through deep stretch four wide and finished second best. BIG PRANKSTER set a pressured pace between rivals two wide to the top of the stretch then was outfinished. KONTEEKEE failed to menace. EL DANDI pressed the pace along the rail into the stretch and weakened late. GUT INSTINCT was no factor. ADMIRAL NELSON pressed the early pace three wide and was through after a half.
