KATE WINS trailed along the inside, shifted out three wide in upper stretch, closed rapidly under left handed urging and got up in the final strides. CHAPTER AND VERSE sprinted to the front soon after the start, set all the pace and just missed hanging on. PAMMY SUE broke outward bumping DON'TDRAINMYPOCKET into FREEDOM PRINCESS at the start, stalked the pace into the stretch and closed a gap late four wide. TO MUCH STYLE chased the winner two wide into the stretch then weakened. DON'TDRAINMYPOCKET bobbled then was bumped between horses at the start, raced wide early, shifted inside nearing the turn, offered a strong bid in upper stretch then came up empty. FREEDOM PRINCESS bumped at the start and had no impact.
