INSIDE JOKE away alertly, prompted the pace two wide into the turn, took over at the five sixteenths marker the widened the balance of the trip to win as her rider pleased. TULSI veered out at the start, settled inside, offered a mild bid two wide into the stretch and finished well clear for second. MAXIMUM GLOW was bumped at the start, settled mid pack and improved position in upper stretch along the inside. DREAM GIRL PAIGE was shut off at the start then failed to menace. SEA DREAMS had no impact. CENTAURIA was no factor. PIPSY CHICK stalked the pace three wide into the stretch then weakened. ABOUT THAT TIME was no threat. CYBER QUEEN bore out bumping MAXIMUM GLOW into SHARON THE DANCER at the start, quickly made the lead, set a pressured pace along the inside until the middle of the turn then was used up. SHARON THE DANCER was bumped at the start and always outrun. SHE STARTED IT was never involved.
