ROYALLY FLUSHED close up from the start, rallied four wide to make the lead nearing the top of the stretch, set the balance of the pace then couldn't hold off the winner. LOGICO allowed to settle, found his best stride late while five wide. VERBIER trailed into the stretch, swung wide and closed gap late. THANKS FRANK sped to the lead soon after the start, set a pressured pace along the inside past the quarter pole, had speed until deep stretch while drifting out to the three path then weakened. BRIO offered a mild bid five wide past the quarter pole then came up empty. MONTAUK COVE gad good early speed four wide then faded. MARKHAMIAN pressed the pace three wide to the top of the stretch then gave way.
