GAPPER unhurried early, closed willingly inside inside the leader in the three path under right then left handed urging and got up in the final strides. INTO GOLD stalked the early pace, slipped through along the rail to make the lead nearing the quarter pole, drifted out to the six path entering the stretch, set the balance of the pace then couldn't hold off the winner. QUIET AMIGO stalked the early pace, offered a strong bid four wide on the turn then was outfinished while racing in the six path. SHOW SLIDING HOME trailed into the turn then passed tiring rivals two wide through the stretch. EL MARRO had speed through the turn then weakened. BISCUITS AND GRITS was no factor. BAD BOY BOOGIE rushed to the lead soon after the start, set a pressured pace two wide for nearly a half mile then was used up. NEBULOSA pressed the early pace three wide and was through after a half.
