HAVE A CIGAR well placed, rallied four wide to make the lead in deep stretch and just lasted under strong handling. POLIZON drifted out bumping GUNN'S ROAR at the start, was unhurried, closed rapidly between horses three wide through deep stretch and just missed. A BIT OF CAPTAIN trailed inside, swung wide and closed a gap late in the middle of the racetrack. LEO'S LEGACY veered out at the start and improved position late five wide. NANTUCKET sprinted to a clear lead soon after the start, widened into the stretch, set the pace until the late stages then was outfinished. UNION SWAG failed to respond. IT'S LAST CALL was no factor. GUNN'S ROAR was bumped at the start, chased the pace down the backstretch, offered a mild bid two wide midway on the turn then came up empty.
