ICE BLAST unhurried early, advanced steadily, rallied four wide in upper stretch to make the lead inside the furlong marker after being struck once with a left handed crop then finished full of run under a hand ride to win going away. DARK BARON raced four wide through the first turn, stalked the pace three wide down the backstretch, made the lead midway on the second bend, set the pace until deep stretch then was no match for the winner and held on for second by a narrow margin. ROYAL DRAGOON never far back, finished with good courage along the rail. KADESH set the pace along the inside through the first turn, gave up the advantage briefly, set the pace into the far turn, kept on into the stretch and weakened late. MONTAUK COVE pressed the pace two wide through the first turn, made the lead briefly, kept pressure into the far turn then gave way in the lane. NAPA DUDE was no factor. BROADWAY SKY vied for the lead two wide and was through after a half.
