KONTEEKE trailed into the stretch, circled his field five wide under right handed urging to make the lead at the sixteenth marker and finished full of run to win going away under a hand ride. VODKA N GINGERALE unhurried early, rallied three then four wide to draw on even terms for the lead at the sixteenth pole then was no match for the winner. BIG PRANKSTER pressed the pace two wide for three furlong, made the lead, gave up the advantage late on the turn, kept on inside rivals and was outfinished. ADMIRAL NELSON was hustled to the lead soon after the start, set a pressured pace along the inside for three furlongs, shifted out three wide at the head of the lead then was outfinished. PICARO stalked the early pace, rallied three wide to make the lead late on the turn, set the pace until deep stretch then weakened.
