MR. MOX took command between rivals early then secured the rail heading to the first turn, handled outer pressure from the three eighths, dueled between runners past the three sixteenths, briefly shook clear under a drive soon into the lane, dug in when encountered by BEACH BOY past the sixteenth marker, battled head to head with that one through the final yards and got the bob. BEACH COWBOY showed speed then rated back to race behind foes into the first turn, angled out nearing the three eighths, edged up four wide into the far turn then bid three deep past the three sixteenths, re engaged the winner past the sixteenth pole, battled gamely and just missed. PUDGE BOY PALACE settled well back while saving ground, was under pressure leaving the far turn, swung out widest in the drive and closed steadily. BARON'S LEGACY prompted the leaders three wide, took closer order past the quarter pole then was stalled behind foes soon after, shifted out three to four wide in upper stretch but failed to generate a solid finish. SANPIRODU, urged from the gate, tracked outside the winner then bid soon into the backstretch, pressed then sparred between foes nearing the lane, failed to kick on a sixteenth from home and weakened.
