DOC'S MIRACLE vied outside a rival, poked a head in front leaving the three eighths, shook clear and shifted in leaving the quarter pole, responded to solid encouragement and pulled away. TIPMANEE bumped with an inner rival soon after the break, took over between foes then dropped in and set a pressured pace, dueled with the winner into the backstretch, carried that scrum into the far turn, steadied briefly as the winner cleared near the quarter pole, shifted out to chase, switched over to her correct lead in mid stretch and dug in to hold down the place. PINKY SWEAR saved ground, took closer order chasing past the three sixteenths, eased out in upper stretch and churned on. KITTYUP bumped with TIPMANEE in the opening sixteenth then vied inside a pair, chased two to three wide and in the clear through the backstretch run, failed to kick on past the three sixteenths and faded. JUDY G drifted in at the break and was off slow, lagged off the pace and off the rail and failed to get involved. BEE TOO SWEET, off slow when drifting in, saved ground and was outrun. An objection by the rider of TIPMANEE against the winner alleging interference near the quarter pole was not allowed.
