AZTEC settled early while saving ground, steadied when in a bit close near the five eighths, gathered momentum two wide leaving the far turn, shifted back inside with progress into the stretch, kept grinding under solid handling, drifted out some very late and just got up. FAN CLUB broke a step slow, edged up past the three quarter pole to be within range, split rivals nearing the far turn, bid outside the leader and under a ride three sixteenths out, dueled on a slim lead into the lane, kept on gamely but was nipped at the wire. HAWKSTONE stalked off the inside, shifted out and moved up four wide with a bid nearing the five eighths, cleared with a half to go, dug in when joined from his outside leaving the quarter pole, fought gamely two wide and to the inside of FAN CLUB past the sixteenth marker then gave way stubbornly between rivals. MORNING THOUGHTS steadied off heels after a furlong, was used three wide soon after, chased the leader through the backstretch run, came four wide for the drive and kept on with some effort. WALDRIP , four wide pursuing past the three eighths, faded. SHIPMAN cleared early then wandered outward into the stretch the first time, ceded to an outer foe near the five eighths then steadied when getting out near the half, faltered past the three eighths and was eased through the lane.
