RED CANDY APPLE drifted in a bit at the break and bumped with ELLINGER, corrected and quickly cleared, set the pace towards the inside, repelled an outer threat from NOT SO HOLY entering the lane, spurted back to a clear advantage then held firm while on his left lead. NOT SO HOLY , bumped at the break, regrouped and rushed up to take chase past the three eighths, closed in and bid outside the winner approaching the stretch, was turned away while on his left lead, flattened out late but remained clear for the place. ISSANO settled off the pace four to five wide outside rivals, came under a ride leaving the far turn, circled five wide into the stretch then leveled off to a nice stride through the final sixteenth. ELLINGER , bumped and pinched back at the break, regrouped to save ground, gathered momentum saving ground into the stretch, chased to the sixteenth pole but failed to sustain. SIR CHANCE A LOT came out at the break making solid contact with NOT SO HOLY, straightened and hustled up to chase, drifted out leaving the far turn then came up empty. VILALUZ , between rivals into the turn, failed to get involved. An objection by the rider of NOT SO HOLY against the winner leaving the gate was not allowed.
