BIRTHDAY GIRL lost the path shortly after the start, tracked five-wide down the backstretch, then four-wide through the turn, advanced on the leaders approaching the quarter-pole, bid five-wide at the top of the stretch, and gradually wore down a game TIGER DIVISION in the final yards to prevail. TIGER DIVISION ducked out at the start, making contact with QUIRKY RIDE, moved up to take over the lead near the five-furlong pole, fended off the advance of several challengers through the turn to take a short lead turning for home, kept on well under steady handling, then gave way grudgingly in the late stages. ITALIAN IVY was coaxed early to get forward position, then settled in mid-pack down the backstretch, moved up through the turn to loom just behind the leading trio late on the turn, swung five-wide into the stretch, loomed a big threat in upper stretch but could not go with the top two in the final furlong. QUIRKY RIDE got bumped and took up after the start, then rushed up the inside to join the early pace fray, backed off a bit to a tracking position through the turn, then made a bid for the lead after passing the quarter pole, tried to split horses at the three-sixteenths marker, but got shut off, angled over the the rail

but was not doing enough late to pose a threat. GOING STREAKIN broke well and was three-wide pressing the early pace, went on late on the turn with TIGER DIVISION, but weakened a bit in upper stretch and was outkicked to the wire. COOKIN THE BOOKS hesitated at the start and was off slowly, stayed four to five wide, made a mild middle move on the turn, but could not sustain the effort in the stretch. TEGWAR was outrun through the early stages and kept on late to pass tired foes. HANDLE ON YOU broke out at the start, making light contact with MISS MAKENNA, settled in mid-pack along the rally, then struggled to keep pace through the turn and was unable to threaten in the stretch. . MISS MAKENNA got brushed from the inside at the start but was still away well, briefly close up, dropped back before the turn, and had little to offer in the stretch. CODA MIA bobbed slightly at the start but was still first to the front, ceded the lead to TIGER DIVISION after the initial furlong, raced close up through the early stages, the weakened late on the turn and tired in the stretch.

VAST HORIZONS got away well, contested the early pace inside of two rivals, assumed sole possession of the lead going into the far turn, and kept on with grinding finish to outlast the rest to the finish. SNOW KING raced five-wide through the first turn, then four-wide with the tracking trio, launched a steady bid from the seven-sixteenths marker, kept a consistent pace into the stretch, and outfinished the rest to gain the place. GOD OF WINE was the inside horse in the tracking group, responded when asked midway through the far turn, but was without a path, found a seam near the quarter-pole, tipped out to the two-path for the stretch, moved into second position but failed to change leads, lugged in, and faltered in the late stages. PERMIT TO CARRY got pinballed after the break, then was last and stayed out in the three path through the early running, started a forward move with about three furlongs to run, loomed four wide at the top of the stretch, finished willingly, but ran out of time. MY BOY ROCKY raced between horses in the second flight, saved ground through, but came up empty in the stretch run. CHEESESTEAK settled along the rail at the back of the pack, ran on some to pass tired rivals in the stretch but was never a serious threat. MEMPHIS PHAROAH showed good speed from the break, contested the early lead three-wide on the first turn, went together with VAST HORIZONS down the backstretch, then started to weaken midway through the far turn and stopped in the stretch. MEADOW VALUE hustled out of the gate, vied between horses through the clubhouse turn, and started a steady retreat from early on the backstretch run, and was not persevered with late when hopelessly behind, and galloped out to the finish line.

JUJUBEE hustled to the lead, then was taken under a firm hold, early, was turned loose after passing the half-mile pole, maintained a clear margin through the far turn, and responded when set down in upper stretch and drew off. FINAL SCENE got caught four-wide into the first turn, settled out in the four-path in the run down the backstretch, went three wide while advancing through the far turn, then finished up well to move up into clear second position while no match for the winner. BILLY WHITE SHOES (IRE) steadied slightly just before the first bend, was last turning onto the backstretch and content with that position to the far turn, swept around the field to loom a big threat five-wide into the stretch and finished well to gain third. BRAVITAS was allowed to settle from the break and raced in the back half of the field early on, was having to be hard ridden to keep pace on the far turn, then was kept to task under strong handling and regular urging to maintain position through the stretch, but was unable to improve. MY FATHER'S PLACE settled in a stalking position behind JUJUBEE, came under a stiff drive midway through the far turn but could not make up any ground on that rival then was outfinished in the stretch. JINXZI tracked two-wide in the middle of the pack, went four-wide into the stretch and lacked a finish. OR MAGIQUE settled mid-pack along the rail for the first half-mile, then dropped to last on the far turn and was outrun in the late stages.

GAGLIARDI broke a little awkwardly to the inside putting the inner rival in tight, recovered quickly and hustled to the front, then was left alone to dictate moderate fractions to the far turn with the field spread out behind, was always traveling well, came into the stretch still clear of the rest, responded when roused and held clear to the finish under steady handling and intermittent left and right handed urging. ASKARI came away well, then got in a bit tight midway on the first turn, settled into third position turning onto the backstretch, was inside into the far turn, waited for racing room, tipped out to the two-path for the stretch run, finished well, but could not get to the winner. FIRST OF HIS NAME raced a bit off the early pace in the three-path, moved up through the turn, launched a bid for the lead approaching the quarter pole, loomed a threat at the top of the stretch, but flattened out a bit, holding position to the wire. OCEAN VICTORY got squeezed at the start, steadied, then raced well off the pace in the back half of the field early on, responded when asked to go on heading into the far turn, finished with interest, was mildly gaining but was not quite doing enough in the late stages. GERALDRAYDAPLEGRAY got inside position mid-path, saved ground throughout, but lacked the needed response in the stretch. DREAMING BRO got caught three-wide through the first turn but determined to get a forward position, settled in behind GAGLIARDI for the first half-mile, then lacked a finish. NON FUNGIBLE got pinched back at the start, raced from well behind, and was never a factor. GARDEN LEAVE broke off-balance and ducked in, was a bit rank and hard to place going into the clubhouse turn, backed off and took a position near the rear, made a mild bid going three-to-four wide on the last turn, but had nothing left in the stretch.

BRIGHT STAR pursued the leaders from outside travelling three to four wide into and on the turn, floated six wide leaving that bend commencing a bid and took the lead at the top of the stretch, drew clear then held. LISTENTOURMOTHER bumped with a rival just after the start, tracked from inside not far off the pace, moved out midway on the turn, came into upper stretch six wide, chased the winner home but could make no headway. UNION EMPRESS settled off the pace, shifted in early on turn, saved ground the rest of that bend and improved position inside. FLORENTINE LADY was urged from the break, dueled outside, had no extra late. VOLUNTOLD bumped with a foe after the start, was forwardly-positioned tracking inside, saved ground on the turn, moved out four to five wide in upper stretch, ran on but needed more. VICTURA settled off the pace dropping back toward the rear, raced two to three wide between foes into the turn, came out several paths in the stretch and improved position. INHERENT GRACE settled off the pace, dropped back between foes at the rear, went three to four wide on the turn, ran on. LATE SPRING NIGHT lacked early speed racing back off the leaders, saved ground on the turn, came out a bit for the drive, failed to menace. THIS ONE'S FOR US dueled inside, gave way. G ONE BOUND chased up close briefly in the early going, moved in a bit, dropped back three wide on the turn. REAL N SPECTACULAR moved out early, was outside foes four to five wide on the turn coming into upper stretch seven deep, failed to make a bid. AUTHENTIC APPEAL lacked early speed, fanned eight wide into upper stretch, was never near enough to threaten.
