COPPER MISSILE settled off of the pace in the three path, rallied around the far turn to bid for the lead entering the lane, drove clear shortly after then held

sway. DEVIL ANSE laid off of the pace near the inside, came under urging while moving out turning for home, fanned to the five path into the lane and rallied for place. COMPTON broke outwardly, raced off of the pace in the four to three path, progressed four wide turning for home, ran on to bid for place along with an outer foe in the final furlong but got outkicked. ACCREDIT set the pace while moving to the inside around the first turn, drew clear reaching the three furlong pole, but was caught by an outer bidder entering upper stretch and faded. OBELISK was subtly put to tight quarters between horses at the start, laid off of the pace near the inside, then moved up three wide and between horses in the final furlong. ZAPRUDER pursued from the three to two path and failed to menace. WARLANDER tugged along the inside early on, pulled under a strong hold while close up in the two path around the first turn, chased the clear leader from the two path around the far turn, got outkicked by outer rivals at the quarter pole then faded between horses. GLOBAL SENSATION tracked near the inside, chased in the three to four path in upper stretch and tired. HILLIARD broke slowly, trailed in the two path and never got involved while hanging on his left lead. FAYETTE SPIRIT prompted three to two wide, but faded with three furlongs to go and weakened between horses shortly after.
