FIVE A SIDE pursued from midpack in the three to two path, shifted three wide to range up outside of the top pair at the quarter pole, issued a bold challenge entering the lane, kicked away strongly under mild urging then was put to hand with a sixteenth to go. HUMBLED stalked along the inside, bid two wide rounding the far turn, forged an advantage under the three sixteenths pole but got quickly outkicked by an outer challenger leaving it, proved no match for that one then held place. HOLD MY HALO lacked speed along the inside, took the far turn in the three path, swung out to the six path into the lane and ran on to miss place. YELLOW SUN DRESS stalked from the two to three path into the backstretch, chased within striking range around the far turn, got outkicked and floated four wide at the quarter pole, sustained pursuit to vie for how into the final furlong, but flopped back to her left lead and yielded late. ALL NIGHT REVIVAL tracked from the four path, got floated five wide at the quarter pole then gave way. CHAMPAGNE NIGHTS took back from between horses at the start, trailed in the two path, took the far turn in the four to five path before fanning to the seven path into the lane, and failed to factor. APPELLATE pursued from the three path, chased around the far turn and faded. CAYUCOS bobbled a bit at the start, sped clear early on, got collared by an outer bidder at the quarter pole then stopped.
