VINO SUBITO brushed with an inner foe at the start, tracked along the inside, shifted out to the six path in upper stretch, rallied to bid outside of the leaders in the final furlong and drove past. CAPTAIN GABE raced close up two wide and between foes while under urging approaching the turn, bid and vied among rivals turning for home, kept on through midstretch, but got outkicked by an outer foe in the final furlong then prevailed for place. PLAYONWORDS broke sharply and crossed over early on, showed the way along the inside, got headed by an outer pair at the quarter pole, kept on while hanging on his left lead and reclaimed show late. ITCHY stalked three wide, ranged up to bid around the turn, led while leaning out to the five path nearing the lane, but failed to kick clear, yielded between rivals at the sixteenth pole then lost show. CIRCLE THE STORM raced off of the pace in the three path and failed to factor. RIPPIN lacked speed in the four path and got outrun.
