## QUEENSTOWN raced close up inside to the far turn, kept on with a solid run and cleared off to the wire. CARTIER GOLD inside run quarter pole, rallied on into stretch mildly for place. COVE SPRING no speed to far turn, ran on widest quarter pole for show spot. FROSTY MOJITO sprinted off quickly with the lead stayed to quarter pole gave in. MINSTRELLY awkstart from the gate, trailed to the half and improved position. LABILE no speed early on with mild improvement while no threat. CANDLE'S LEGACY off rail run to far turn never far back gave in readily and faded. DEL MAR SUNRISE (IRE) bit slow from

the gate and never menaced thereafter. SMOKED PEACH pressed pace in the two path, floated out in stretch while fading. TOGETHER AGAIN never a menace throughout. UNA QUAEDAM never threatened at any pole. ALWAYS IN VOGUE broke sharp, dropped back quicky and outrun.
