BIG GARRY outside run to quarter pole rallied in earnest to prove best wire. WAR LEGEND inside chase to the turn, blocked stretch angled in probably best. FINAL COUNTDOWN good position outside to the turn, rallied along stretch for 3rd. POLICY CHANGE bore out, checked after the start unhurried early closed gap late. JUJUBEE unhurried early, raced along evenly with no response when needed. ZAP D'ETAT no speed to the stretch ran on to closed gap in late going. FIGHT TIME slow start from inside, raced back to turn leveled off in stretch. IN THE DARK no speed to the turn, ran on from quarter pole to close the gap. SHELLAC rail speed, pressured to the stretch, used up and gave in readily. ENGINEER broke awkward start, trailed early never factored throughout. ZAPPING STRIKE pressed pace in two path to deep stretch, stopped late going. NOMOLIMBO had a slow start and never factored throughout.
