LATE TO THE GAME broke through the gate pre-race, stalked in the four path, bid in upper stretch, gained command at the sixteenth pole and drew clear. RIGHTINTHATWRONG stalked along the inside, took rail aim in upper stretch, ran on and edged place in the final sixteenth. WISCONSIN GAL showed the way in the two path, held sway in upper stretch, but got caught by an outer bidder at the sixteenth pole, yielded and saved show. CACHINNATION laid off of the pace three wide, shifted out to the five path in upper stretch and rallied to miss show. MISS BOURBON broke a step slow while last away, saved ground at the rear then rallied up the rail. THEATRIX pressed the leader from the three path, then faded between horses. OAK ALLEY bumped with an outer rival at

the start, pursued from the three path and lacked a bid. MOON LAW broke through the starting gate pre-race, bumped with an inner foe at the start, pursued from midpack in the four path and failed to threaten. CAVATELLI lacked speed in the two to five path and between horses, then failed to factor. SUGAR HI lacked speed near the inside and failed to factor. HI BARBIE raced towards the rear in the three to four path, floated out to the six path into the lane and never got involved. SWEET BEBSI chased in the two path, then along the inside around the turn and caved between horses in upper stretch.
