PEPPER MILL vied between foes early then gained a slim advantage to the inside of ARIZONA REINA heading to the half, edged clear under some rating past the three eighths, opened up under firm asking soon into the stretch then continued to pour it on while steadily hand ridden through the final sixteenth. STAY SASSY broke outward, corrected and chased four deep into the turn, circled five wide into the lane, pursued on her left lead and outside a trio near the sixteenth pole and continued with effort to nab the place. GO GO SADIE , off the pace, rated off heels near the half, tipped three wide in upper stretch, moved up between runners with chase past the sixteenth pole and kept on willingly to the inside of STAY SASSY. TWO BAR urged along chasing the pace while saving ground, took closer order past the five sixteenths, remained towards the inner rail while inside rivals past the sixteenth marker and faded. ARIZONA REINA had speed three deep, prompted the pace outside the winner leaving the far turn, stayed on to chase between horses leaving mid stretch then faded late. DADS ESTRELLA , three wide between rivals nearing the turn, came four wide into the lane, shifted out but lacked a rally. LOTSA LACE , reluctant to load, showed speed and vied inside a pair of runners early on, rated back headed ot the half, failed to kick on leaving the three eighths and faltered.
