## Footnotes | View Glossary Of Terms

STREET GUN, bumped at the break, corrected and hustled up soon after to join the pace fray, vied outside LEGAL MOUSSE under rating then cleared leaving the three eighths as his rider deftly adjusted the left iron, responded when set down in upper stretch, eagerly drew out and was kept to a drive. LEGAL MOUSSE disputed the pace inside rivals then emerged in a battle to the inside of the winner past the half, steadied off that one's heels with three furlongs remaining, shifted out to pursue, failed to make inroads leaving mid stretch but kept on willingly to the wire. LORD STERLING, taken to rate off the pace and off the inside, quickly gained four wide outside foes nearing the quarter pole, chased to mid stretch then flattened out. SUAVE VRON rushed up five wide nearing the turn, pursued to the head of the lane then came up empty. FIRST ELDAAFIRST bobbled outward and bumped with the winner at the break, dropped off the pace then raced three deep leaving the three eighths, was bumped by an inner foe nearing the stretch then failed to kick on. OSCAR PRODUCTION, off the pace between foes leaving the three eighths, drifted out and bumped FIRST ELDAAFIRST approaching the lane, shifted in and failed to drum up a late kick. HARTMAN, off slowly, was not a factor. FANCY VERY FANCY, away alertly, drafted back off the pace, raced four wide

nearing the lane and lacked a response. BADGERS FACE vied briefly between foes then faltered leaving the three furlong pole.
