IMMELMANN broke alertly and was forwardly placed early on, rushed up along the backstretch run, pressed the pace three wide into the turn, confronted COLONEL PUNCH at the quarter marker then dueled that rival to mid-stretch, repelled the runner-up in deep stretch and drew clear late. COLONEL PUNCH broke alertly and assumed early command, set a pressured pace along the backstretch run, showed the way into the turn then met the bid of IMMELMANN at the quarter marker, dueled inside of that rival into the stretch, battled into the final furlong, was repelled in the final sixteenth and held for second at the finish. CINCO MAJESTIC away in good order, pressed the early pace from between rivals, was well placed to the turn and saved ground nearing the quarter pole, chased the dueling leaders into the stretch, could not muster the needed response into the final sixteenth but held well late for third. RACER REX was forwardly placed early, stalked the pace three wide along the backstretch run then went up to press the pace between rivals into the turn, lost position nearing the quarter marker, weakened in the stretch and was outfinished for the show honors. TOO TALL TO CALL raced close up to the early pace then took back, saved ground into the turn, angled out to upper stretch, made a mild rally between foes in the drive but could not threaten the leaders in deep stretch. GIANOLA settled off of the early pace, coaxed from the two path along the turn, swung three wide to upper stretch, dove to the rail at the furlong marker, needed more in the final sixteenth but improved position late. ANNIVERSAIRE D'OR broke a bit awkwardly and was off a step slowly, hustled to chase the early pace, ran in pursuit three wide to the quarter marker, spun four wide to upper stretch, lacked the needed response in the drive and gave way in the final stages. BENDETTIOE broke slowly and lacked early speed, coaxed two then three wide nearing the top of the stretch and did not factor in the late stages.
