CATALINA COCKTAIL settled just off of the early pace then tracked between foes into the first turn, got caught a bit in tight along that bend but found room into the backstretch and was well placed approaching the half-mile, bid two wide and between foes into the far turn, engaged with BINGO BABY and dueled that rival into the stretch, repelled the runner-up into the final sixteenth and kicked clear late to prove best. BINGO BABY was forwardly placed while saving ground in the early stages, tracked the decent pace from the inside along the backstretch run, mounted a rail bid nearing the quarter marker, dueled with CATALINA COCKTAIL into the stretch, was turned away by the winner in the final sixteenth but was clear of the rest for second. P. S. RISING STAR hopped then was shuffled back at the start and was off a bit slowly, settled to the first turn then was unhurried to the backstretch run, roused two wide to the far turn, angled four to five wide to upper stretch, closed in the final furlong, could not impact the top pair late but was clear in the end for third. POKER ALICE was forwardly placed in the early running while three wide, went up and stalked the solid pace into the backstretch run, pressed into the far turn then vied for the lead three wide nearing the top of the stretch, could not keep pace nearing the furlong pole and weakened in the final sixteenth. SUNGLASSES (GB) broke a step slowly, settled while saving ground to the first turn, was caught in tight and steadied along that bend, was unhurried to the backstretch, coaxed just off of the rail into the far turn, got caught in traffic nearing the quarter marker then ran in pursuit to upper stretch, was outkicked at the furlong grounds and did not mount the needed late response. BANGIE GO broke alertly, showed good early speed and set the pace to the first turn, carved out solid fractions to the half-mile marker, showed the way to the far turn while off of the rail, was overtaken at the quarter pole then faded in the stretch drive. FOREST ACCLAMATION was forwardly placed early on while outside of rivals, tracked the pace four wide into the backstretch run, was well placed to the

far turn, ran in pursuit to the quarter marker, swung widest to upper stretch and gave way in the drive. VULIN broke in the air and was off slowly, settled while saving ground to the first turn, maintained an inside path to the far turn and did not factor in the stretch drive. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time.
