BROWN TOWN raced close up to the early pace while three wide and between foes, went up and pressed the pace into the turn, vied for the lead to upper stretch and battled GREAT KING (FR) to the furlong marker, held that foe at bay to the final sixteenth, shook free in deep stretch and kept to task late to prove best. GREAT KING (FR) showed good speed away from the start, disputed the solid early pace four wide along the backstretch, vied for the lead four wide into the turn then met the bid of BROWN TOWN to upper stretch, hung into the final furlong, could not match strides with the winner into the final sixteenth and was second best. DRILL'S LI'L MAN contested the early pace two wide and between foes, dueled inside of a pair of rivals into the turn, yielded into the stretch and just held for third at the wire. BIG DON'S SMILING broke slowly, rushed up between rivals in the early stages, chased two then three wide nearing the quarter marker, swung four wide to upper stretch, could not muster the needed late response and missed at the wire for third. SAINT PIO hustled away from the start, contested the solid early pace from inside of rivals, pressed the pace to the turn, could not keep pace nearing the quarter marker and faded. SHIP IT RED settled while saving ground in the early stages, maintained an inside path to the quarter marker, made a mild bid into the stretch, could not sustain that run to the final sixteenth and did not threaten late. MASHHAD FLATS settled while never far back early on, tracked the solid pace from between rivals along the backstretch run, lost ground into the turn and was coaxed two wide to the quarter pole, could not find more into the stretch and did not factor late. DIXON TUFF rated just off of the early pace, tracked from outside of rivals along the backstretch then chased four wide into the turn, could not keep pace nearing the top of the stretch and weakened in the lane.
