SILVERBULLITBADGER raced close up to the early pace, stalked three wide to the turn, roused to the quarter marker and confronted FIRST CALL at that station, dueled to mid-stretch, turned away the runner-up into the final sixteenth and drew clear. FIRST CALL broke alertly and assumed early command, set the pace between rivals along the backstretch, met the bid of SILVERBULLITBADGER at the quarter marker then dueled that rival into the stretch, battled to the furlong pole, was repelled into the final sixteenth and was second best. MR LOVE MUFFIN settled off of the early pace, coaxed two then three wide nearing the quarter pole, could not find the needed response in the stretch but kept on well into the final sixteenth and got up for the show honors. BIYOMBO hustled leaving the start, went up and pressed the early pace from the inside, was turned away nearing the quarter marker, angled out and chased three to four wide to upper stretch, could not keep pace with the top pair into the stretch and just missed for third at the wire. ARIZONA JEREMY bobbed then lost his path at the start and was off slowly, settled while saving ground early on, maintained an inside path to the quarter marker and did not offer a response in the stretch.
