BANGO GAL settled off of the early pace and shifted to the rail along the backstretch run, stalked from the inside heading to the turn, was well placed to the quarter marker then bid from the rail nearing the top of the stretch, took command nearing the furlong pole and drew away while in hand in the final sixteenth. DISTORTED LOUV hustled away from the start, pressed the early pace along the backstretch run, attended to the pace two then three wide into the turn, vied for the lead to upper stretch, was no match for the winner into the final furlong and stayed on to be second best. THETRIBEHASSPOKEN tracked the early pace from outside of rivals, chased three then four wide nearing the quarter marker, ran in pursuit into the stretch, finished evenly in the drive but ran on late to earn the show honors. SWISS DANCER away in good order, rated off of the early pace and saved ground into the turn, chased from the inside nearing the quarter pole, angled out in upper stretch, needed more in the late stages and was outkicked for third. NEPHELE tracked the early pace from the second flight, chased two wide and between rivals into the turn, ran in pursuit into the stretch then got caught in tight between foes at the furlong pole, kept on into the final sixteenth but could not find the needed late response. LIBERTY CAP broke a bit slowly and was void of speed along the backstretch run, trailed into the turn, swung widest to upper stretch, was able to gain ground in the late stages but did not factor. WHITE PEONY sent for the early lead, assumed command and set a prompted pace along the backstretch run, showed the way into the turn then drifted to the two path nearing the quarter pole, vied for the lead between rivals into upper stretch, could not keep pace nearing the furlong pole and gave way.
