WEST SIDE OKIE hustled up to join the leaders before the turn after a slightly tardy start, loomed three-wide past the quarter pole, then finished up well under steady handling to draw clear in the late stages. KAELY'S CANDY was the near the back to the stretch, then put in a strong rally up the rail to gain the place. DADDYS NINA was initially up with the pace after the break, backed off, angled to the inside for the run through the turn, swung five-wide into the stretch, and finished well to gain the third prize. PRANCING MATILDA settled just behind the pace battle down the backstretch, dropped back on the turn, tried to rally six-wide into the stretch, and finished with some interest but lacked the needed late punch. HIDDEN TIGER mutually bumped with SNEAKY SITUATION at the start was still able to get to the front first, dueled with a pair of rivals to the outside down the backstretch, then went on late on the turn, battled with WEST SIDE OAKIE to mid-stretch, then gave way. LOOP OF HENLE was slow to begin and chased from far back, ran on a bit in the late stages but was unable to improve. SNEAKY SITUATION broke in and bumped with HIDDEN TIGER, then attended the early pace from between horses to the turn, dropped out near the five-sixteenths and tired in the stretch.
