LITTLE TROUBLE was pushed for a forward position from the start but was not fast enough to win the race to the first turn, was in a bit tight early, then moved up to join STREET HUMOR on the lead, dueled that one to the far turn, then assumed command past the quarter pole and drew off to a commanding lead in the stretch. SURPSRINGLYPERFECT settled in mid-pack three-wide, ran on well through the stretch, and outdueled a rival to gain the place. FIREMAN DAN settled 4-wide just behind the dueling leaders, responded when put into a drive approaching the three-furlong pole, then dueled with FIREMAN DAN for a minor award, got headed at the wire and had to settle for third. STREET HUMOR was sent hard from the start to get the early lead, tried to slow the pace down but was joined by LITTLE TROUBLE in the run down the backstretch with the rest in close attendance, fought back when that rival bid for the lead approaching the stretch but tired and could not threaten. CODE BREAKER tracked the pacesetters close up three-wide, then lacked a finish. BERNALINHO settled inside mid-pack, moved out to set up a wide rally in the stretch, but drifted out to the center of the course, was put to a drive in the stretch, but could not make up the lost ground.
