LOOKIN FOR CURLY secured the inside position in the tracking group, was under a slight hold through the first half, let loose at that point, bided time inside through the turn, then responded when set down near the quarter pole, rallied up the rail and got up in the final yards. WOODROW CALL took the early lead and attempted to slow the pace, maintained a narrow advantage to the far turn, then had something left when asked to go on, quickened midway on the turn, held on well to deep stretch but could not hold off the winner in the final yards. WEST IS WEST tracked three-wide to the far turn, made a mild bid, then faltered in the stretch. KING OF THE DISCO settled at the back of the compact field through the early stages, then struggled to keep up as the pace quickened, but did manage to improve a position. HUNTING FOR GOLD tracked close up three-wide to the far turn, then tired and lacked a finish. LEGAL MOUSSE lost action in the rear shortly after the break, was pulled up, and transported from the track via the equine ambulance.

BAIE LONGUE settled in along the rail well behind the pacesetting duo, took the inside path through the far turn, waited for some room to the stretch, tipped out to the three path in upper stretch and finished strong under steady handling to take down the top prize. DEL RAYO dueled through the first half-mile with NO ORDINARY TIGER, got the better of that rival on the far turn, then fought back gamely when challenged by KING ELVIS late on the far turn, gained the upper hand on that foe by mid-stretch but could not hold off the winner in the final yards. KING ELVIS tracked behind the dueling leaders through the early stages, advanced three-wide late on the far turn to bid for the lead, battled with a resurgent DEL RAYO to mid-stretch, but could not get past that one and weakened in the late stages. UNCHARTED was allowed to settle from the break, lost some ground on the pack going into the far turn, then ran on a bit late to improve. STRADIVARIAN settled near the back and was having to be coaxed along through the first half, then lacked a rally. NO ORDINARY TIGER dueled to the outside of DEL RAYO, trading the lead several times along the way, the gave way approaching the quarter pole and had little left for the stretch run.

GREAT KING (FR) broke well, stalked the early pace battle four-wide, moved up through the turn to take command passing the five-sixteenths marker, went



clear in upper stretch then held off a late charge from FORT LANGLEY in the final furlong to prevail. FORT LANGLEY raced in mid-pack towards the inside, swung out to the four path for the stretch run and found best stride late, chased the leader in deep stretch, but had to settle for second with a big gap to the next finisher. OUTOFQUEMADO was outpaced and raced her the back of the main pack in down the backstretch, launched a bid with three furlongs to run, kept to the inside and finished up to oufinished the rest of the field to grab the minor award well behind the top two. RONAMO was very slow into stride despite the efforts of the rider, dropped far back early, then rallied late to pass over half the field in the stretch to improve. MOUNT ASGARD was very wide throughout, trailed the main pack down the backretch, then came six-wide into the stretch and was mildly gaining. OUR BOLD PRINCE tracked mid-pack but out in the five or six path, advanced on the turn still very wide, then flattened out a bit in deep stretch. MISTER K was initially in the early pace mix, then backed off before the half and steadily retreated through the turn, then lacked a finish but passed a few tired rivals in the late stages. ROPER vied inside of the early pace battle, dropped out at the half, then had little to offer late. OUR BLOKE broke well and got involved in the early pace, went ahead of the rest to duel outside of ROPER going into the turn, was joined by GREAT KING (FR) on the turn as the former dropped out, was competitive to the top of the stretch, then weakened and faded. XTREME MAYHEM got shuffled back after the start, then rushed up the inside to join the early fray, was prominent to the top of the stretch, then tired. BIG DON'S SMILING dwelt at the start, spotted the rest of the field a huge head start and trailed far back throughout. THERE WAS A STEWARDS INQUIRY INTO THE START OF #7 BIG DON'S SMILING. AFTER A REVIEW IT WAS DETERMINED THAT THE HORSE WAS GIVEN A FAIR START AND CAUSED ITS OWN PROBLEM. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time.
