CHASING RAIN was two-deep in a four-way early pace battle, went on with only MOM SAYS into the turn, the took command late on the turn and drew off in the stretch under a steady hand ride. HONOR THE CAT took some time to get going, then was the early trailer, then started to run on through the turn and sustained the rally into the stretch to gain second. MOM SAYS stumbled exiting the gate but recovered quickly, was the outside horse in the early pace scramble, went on with CHASING RAIN through the turn but could not keep up with that one in the stretch and weakened. REACH HIGHER raced in the back half of the field early, ran on in the late stages, bid five or six wide into the stretch and improved. HATAGASAL had no early speed from the break, chased early, then lacked a rally in the stretch and was never a threat. BOTTLE CAPS settled four-wide behind the pace battle, made a mild bid wide into the stretch but lacked a finish. BIG JIMMY was the inside horse in early pace battle to the half-mile pole, dropped out at that point and was not a factor in the later stages. FARENHEIT O C vied three-deep in the early pace mix, dropped out near the seven-sixteenths marker, then had nothing left for the stretch run.
