KANGAROO COAST broke out and made light contact with G DAWG, then tracked the early pace from the inside, angled out to the four-path for the stretch, then finished up well, wore down CANCUN NATIVE on the lead and went clear in the late stages. CANCUN NATIVE pressed the early pace three-wide, took command passing the quarter pole, opened up in upper stretch but could not hold off the rally of the winner in the final yards while finishing well clear of the next horse. CHICK COMMAND contested the early pace from between horses briefly went on with CANCUN NATIVE from the quarter pole into the stretch but could not keep up late but managed to save third. G DAWG took a light bump from the inside rival at the start, then settled in the back through the early stages, then started to run on through the turn, came about six or seven wide into the stretch and sustained the run to improve position while never a serious threat to the top pair. UKRAINE STRONG raced mid-pack down the backstretch, steadied going into the turn, dropped to least, then came back on in the stretch to improve position. MACNAMARA was off a bit awkwardly, saved ground to no avail and lacked a rally. EXCESSIVE THIEVERY raced mid-pack three-wide, made a mild forward move late on the turn but flattened out. BEAU'S CHARM pulled to the lead while a bit rank, had to rivals pressing the issue to the outside to the tun, then, gave way before the quarter pole and stopped to a walk in the stretch, and eased up across the finish line.
